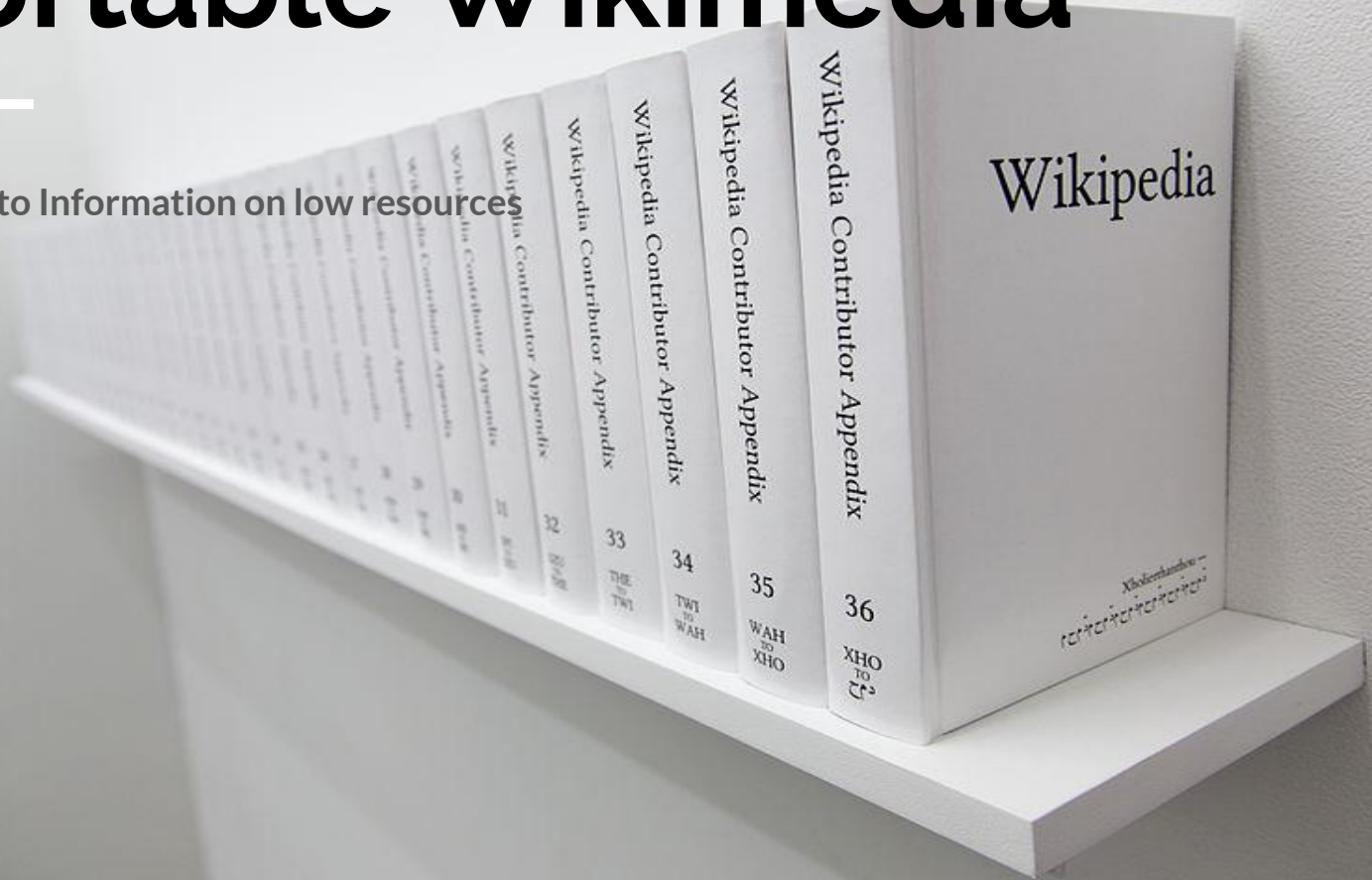

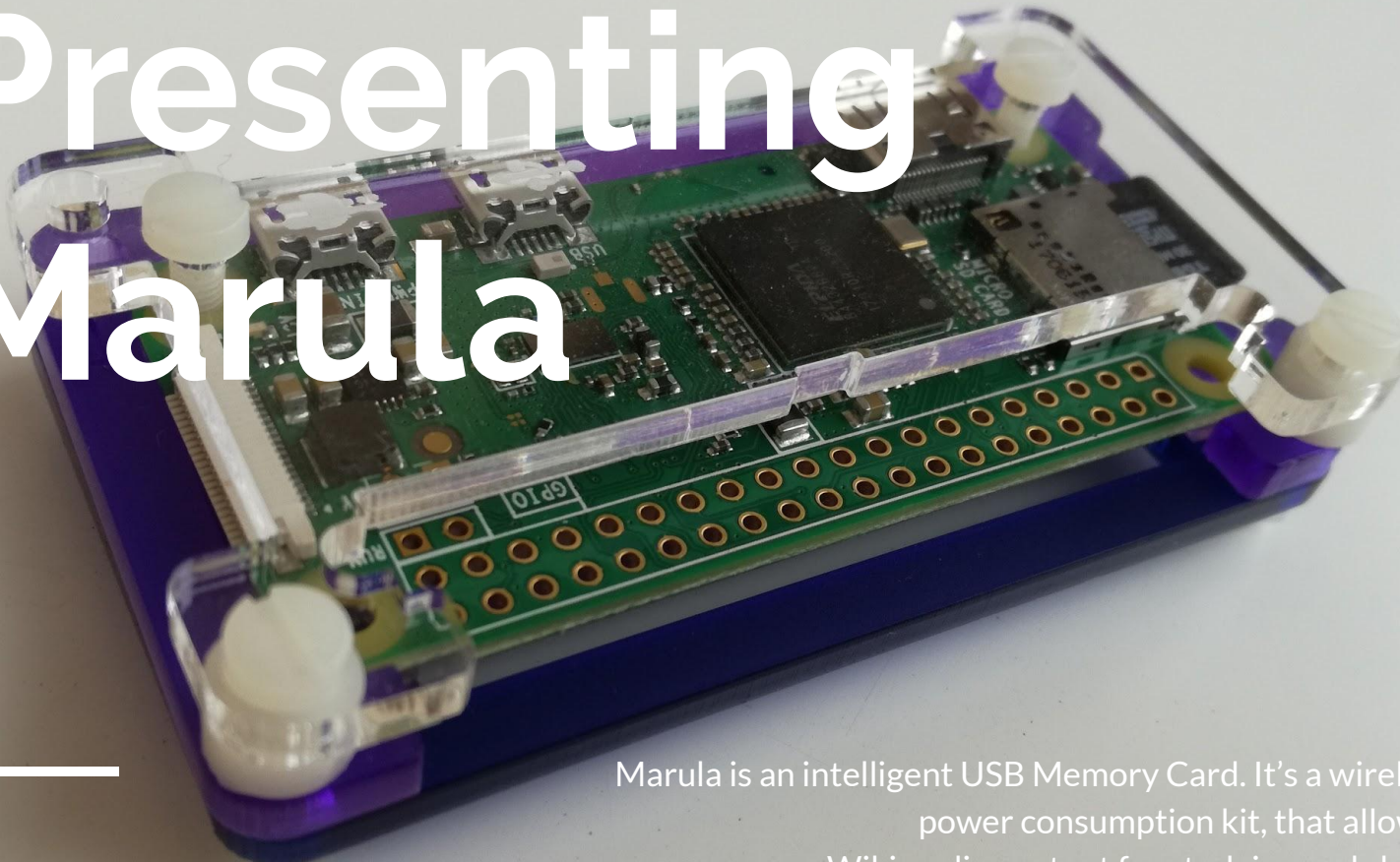

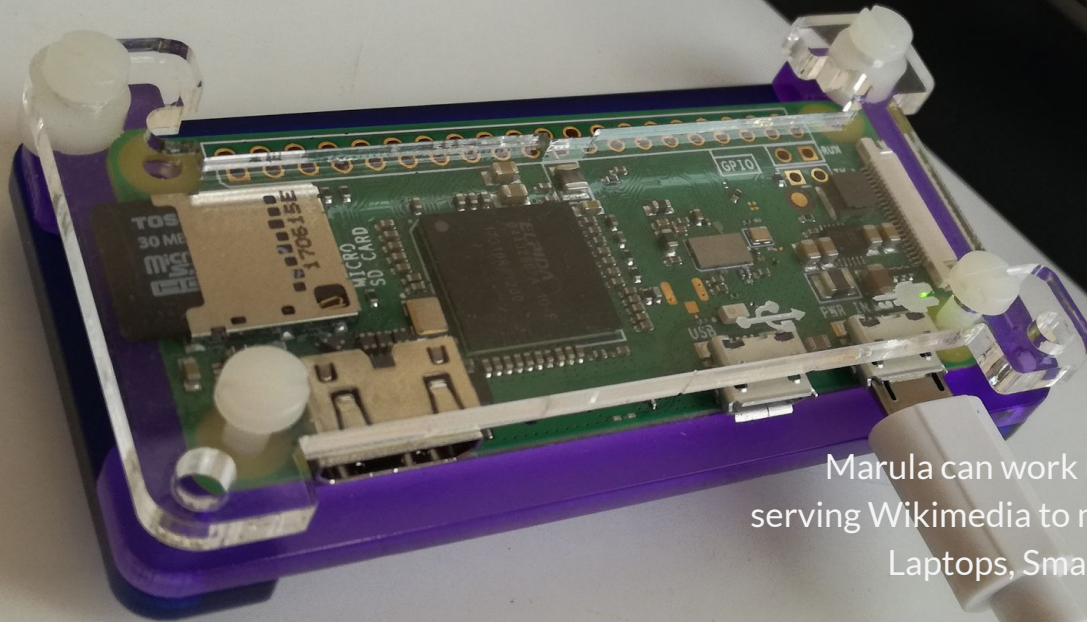


# Presenting Marula



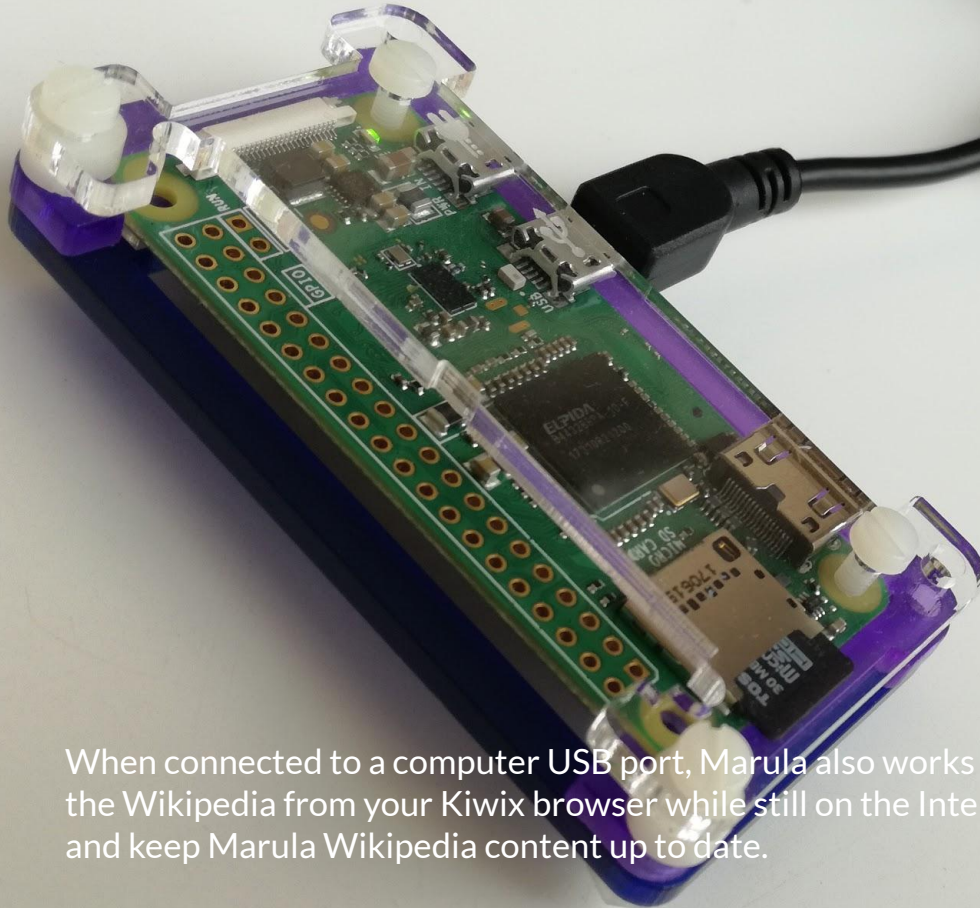
Marula is an intelligent USB Memory Card. It's a wireless enabled, low power consumption kit, that allows you to pocket Wikimedia content for studying and sharing knowledge in several different ways.

# Wikimedia on the air



Marula can work up to 10 hours with a 2500mAh battery, serving Wikimedia to multiple users through a Wireless signal. Laptops, Smartphones and Tablets connect to Marula as if it was a Wireless Access Point. All they need is their built-in Web Browser.

# Share easy, Update easy



When connected to a computer USB port, Marula also works as a USB memory card. This allows to surf the Wikipedia from your Kiwix browser while still on the Internet, extract its Wikimedia files for sharing, and keep Marula Wikipedia content up to date.

# Wikimedia and Internet



Marula also works as a dual access point and wireless router. It allows devices to read the Wikipedia and surf the Internet at the same time, at 3.5Mbps. It is also possible to chain several Marulas wirelessly to extend the signal range.

# Power efficient



Because power demand is very low, Marula can work off a solar panel, allowing to study on remote unconnected locations, directly from your smartphone or laptop.
